Hello Amie.

That is great to hear. We purchased the dispensers from the Total Access Group. These work well for tampons. They do not work well for the square boxes of mini-pads that we distribute. To address this problem, we leave the top of the pad dispenser open. I would suggest doing some research into the packaging of the pads or the size of the mouth of the dispenser.

We use the small dispensers. They cost \$119. You have to create an account to see the prices.
